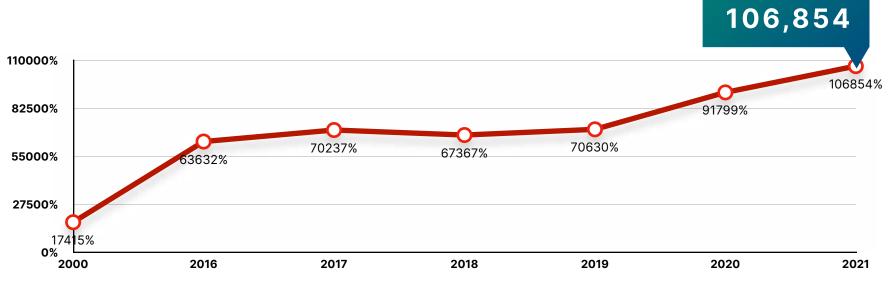

Context

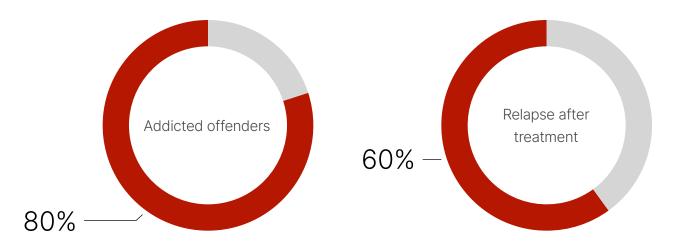
In 2021, annual overdose deaths hit six digits for the first time ever*, showing that in spite of our efforts, there are more people suffering from alcoholism and drug addiction than every before.



Context

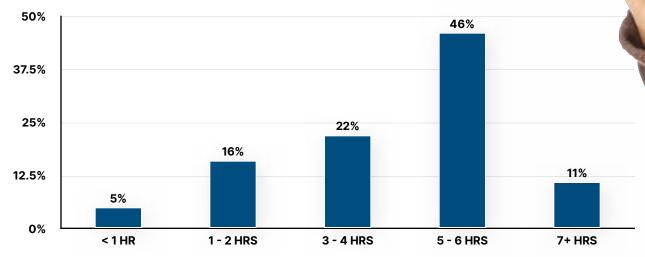
Besides overdose deaths, many individuals in the throes of addiction find themselves at the mercy of the legal system. In fact, an estimated 80 percent* of criminal offenders meet the diagnostic criteria for addiction.

Of all individuals suffering from addiction, only 1 in 10 seeks treatment. But even more alarmingly, up to 60 percent* of those who seek treatment will relapse.



Context

Meanwhile, data shows that almost half of all people who own smartphones and other connected mobile devices are actively using their devices for between 5 and 6 hours per day.

Core Features

Our vision of the Never Alone Recovery app is as a unique combination of features that are critical to maintaining sobriety.

Intuitive UI

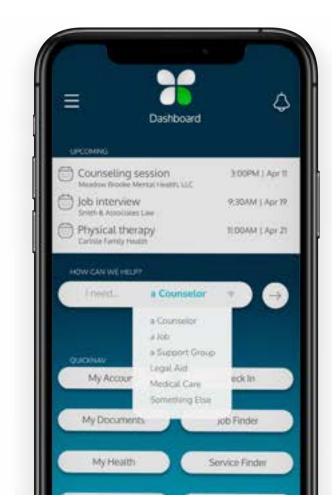
Our user interface should be very familiar and intuitive to anyone who's comfortable with modern mobile tech

Scheduling

Being responsible is a key tenet of many drug rehab programs, so our app will have a robust scheduling and reminders system

Journal

We intend to build a journaling system into our app because many rehabs and even twelve-step programs promote journaling as integral to healing and wellness



Check-ins

Users will be able to check into required meetings and appointments with the app leveraging their GPS to validate check-ins

Job finder

Companies participating in work placement programs for individuals in recovery can post job openings on the app

Service finder

Similar to jobs, users will be able to use our app to locate services they may need, including medical care, legal aid, and more

Core Features

Our vision of the Never Alone Recovery app is as a unique combination of features that are critical to maintaining sobriety.

Health records

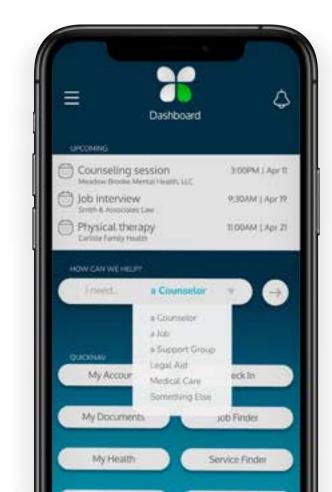
Users should be able to access their health records from one centralized location anytime they need

Since education is crucial to each person's success in recovery, the app will put valuable information at the user's fingertips

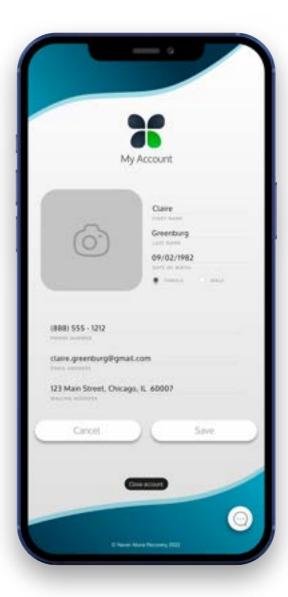
Livechat

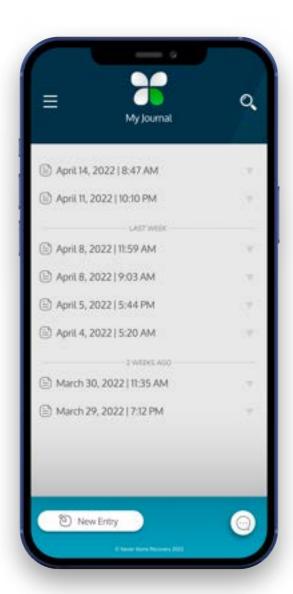

Users' profiles

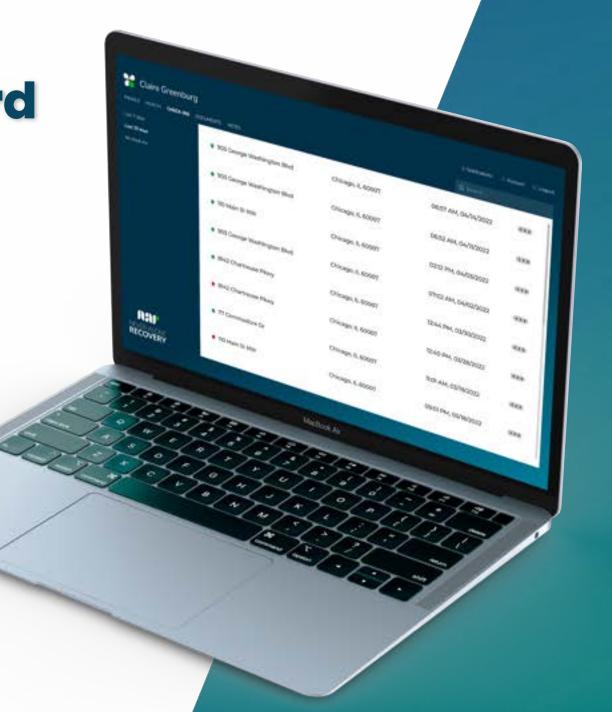
Look up a user's phone number, email, or mailing address

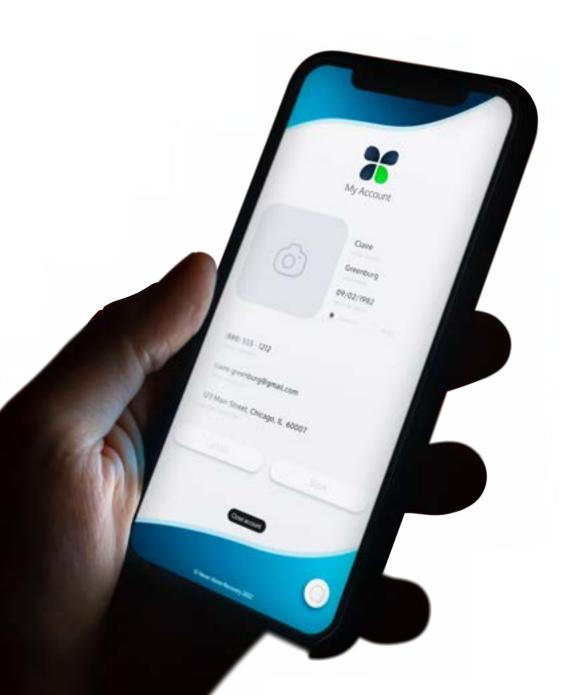
Future Plans

Partnerships
